## SEND Policy:

At Tuba's Play House, we are committed to providing a welcoming and inclusive environment for all children, including those with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND). Our aim is to ensure that all children receive the support they need to achieve their full potential.

Our approach to supporting children with SEND is guided by the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework and the Speacial Educational Needs and Disabilities Code of Practice 2014, which sets out the following requirements:

- We will take a proactive approach to identifying any additional needs, working closely with parents and external agencies to provide appropriate support and resources.
- We will ensure that all children with SEND have access to a broad and balanced curriculum that is tailored to their individual needs and abilities.
- We will make reasonable adjustments to our setting and practice to ensure that children with SEND are not put at a disadvantage compared to their peers.
- We will work closely with parents to ensure that their views and concerns are taken into account and that they are fully involved in their child's education and care.

## To achieve these requirements, we will:

- Regularly review and update our SEND policy and practice to ensure that they are in line with the EYFS and OFSTED requirements.
- Seek additional support or training if needed to provide the best possible care and education for children with SEND.
- Work in partnership with parents to identify any additional needs their child may have and provide appropriate support and resources.

## We expect parents to:

- Be proactive in sharing information with us about their child's needs, abilities, and any medical conditions.
- Act on any advice or recommendations we give regarding their child's well-being and development.

• Work in partnership with us to provide the best possible care and education for their child.
