Funding and Fees Policy

(EYFS 2025 and Sutton Council Guidance)

Purpose

This policy outlines how funded early education is offered at **Tuba's Play House**. It ensures transparency and compliance with the **Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS 2025)** and **Sutton Council** funding agreement.

Funding Entitlements

I offer funded early education places for eligible children in accordance with Sutton Council and Department for Education (DfE) guidance.

Under the EYFS 2025 rollout:

- From April 2024 eligible 2-year-olds can access up to 15 funded hours per week.
- From **September 2024** eligible **children aged 9 months +** can access up to 15 funded hours per week.
- From **September 2025** eligible **children aged 9 months to 2 years** may be entitled to up to 30 funded hours per week.
- The universal 15-hour and extended 15-hour entitlements for 3- and 4-year-olds remain unchanged.

Eligibility and Application Process

The application process for the new entitlements works the same way as the existing 30-hour codes:

- Families apply for funding via the **Government Childcare Service** before the term starts.
- If eligible, an 11-digit code is issued, which must be reconfirmed every 3 months.
- The code includes a start date, end date, and grace period end date.
- A child cannot start or move settings during the grace period.
- Funded hours begin from the start of the term following the child's eligible age.

Delivery of Funded Hours

- Funded hours are offered **term-time only** in line with Sutton Council guidance.
- The setting is **closed during school holidays**, and no fees are charged for funded-only children during this period.
- Families can request **ad hoc holiday sessions** separately, if available, at the standard hourly rate.

Optional Extras and Transparency

- Funding covers childcare only. Optional charges may apply for meals, snacks, outings, or consumables.
- Families may provide their own food or items to avoid or reduce any optional costs.
- No deposits, top-ups, or additional payments are required as a **condition** of accessing a funded-only place.
- All fees for non-funded services are detailed in the contract, not within this policy.

Absences

Funded hours are offered for set days and times during term time.

If a child is absent due to illness, holidays, or other reasons, these hours **cannot be carried forward or replaced**, in line with Sutton Council and DfE funding guidance.

Policy Review

This policy will be **reviewed annually** or sooner if guidance from the **Department for Education (DfE)** or **Sutton Council** changes.
